What is the DSC role for GAOA Projects?

- As the central planning, design, and construction management office for the National Park Service, DSC provides start-to-finish project management and delivery.
- By the end of this fiscal year, DSC will have awarded \$973M in GAOA funds.
- 74% of these GAOA awards were Small Business

How to Engage with DSC?

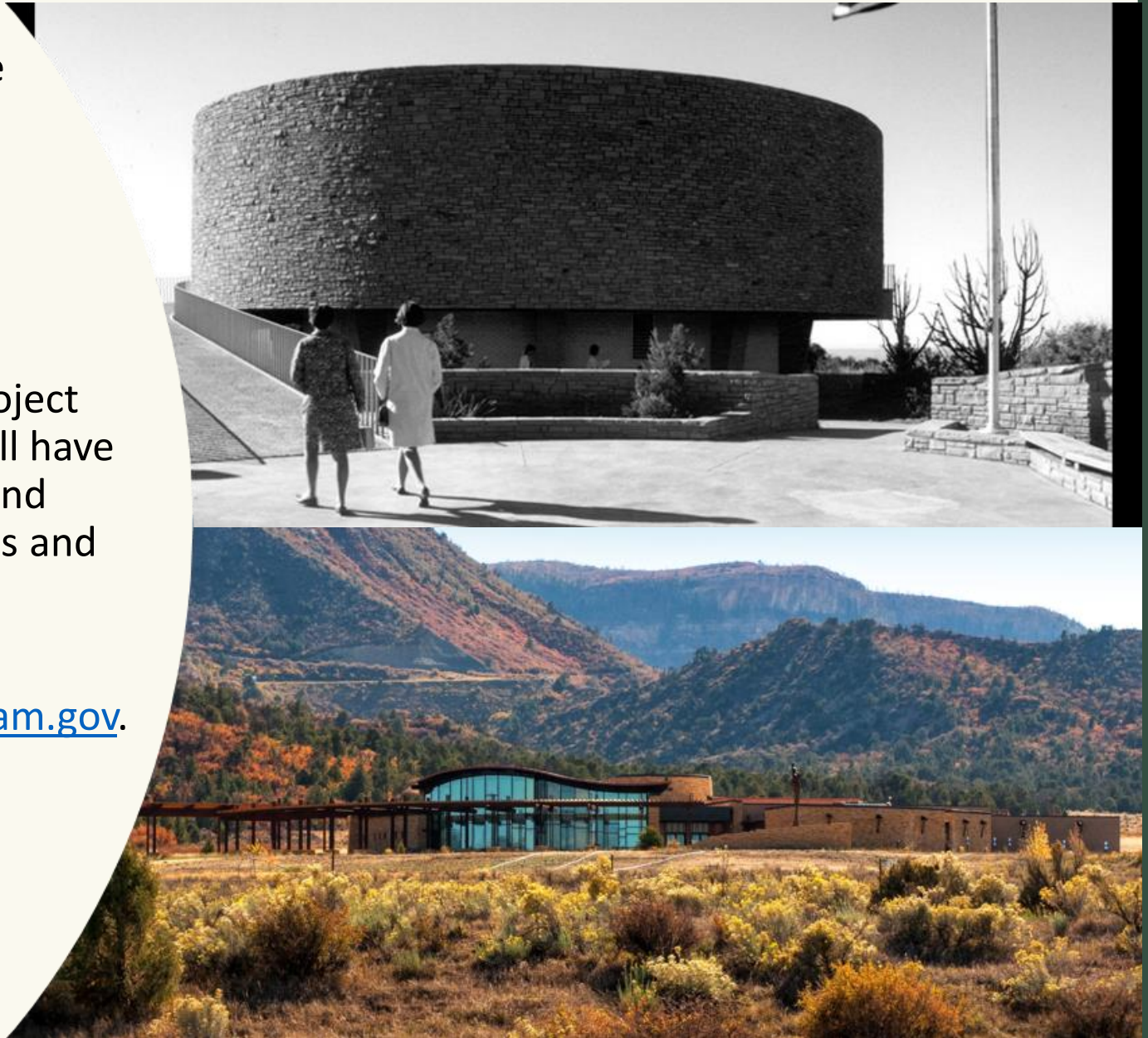

NPS Socioeconomic goals for Fiscal Year 2023 are:

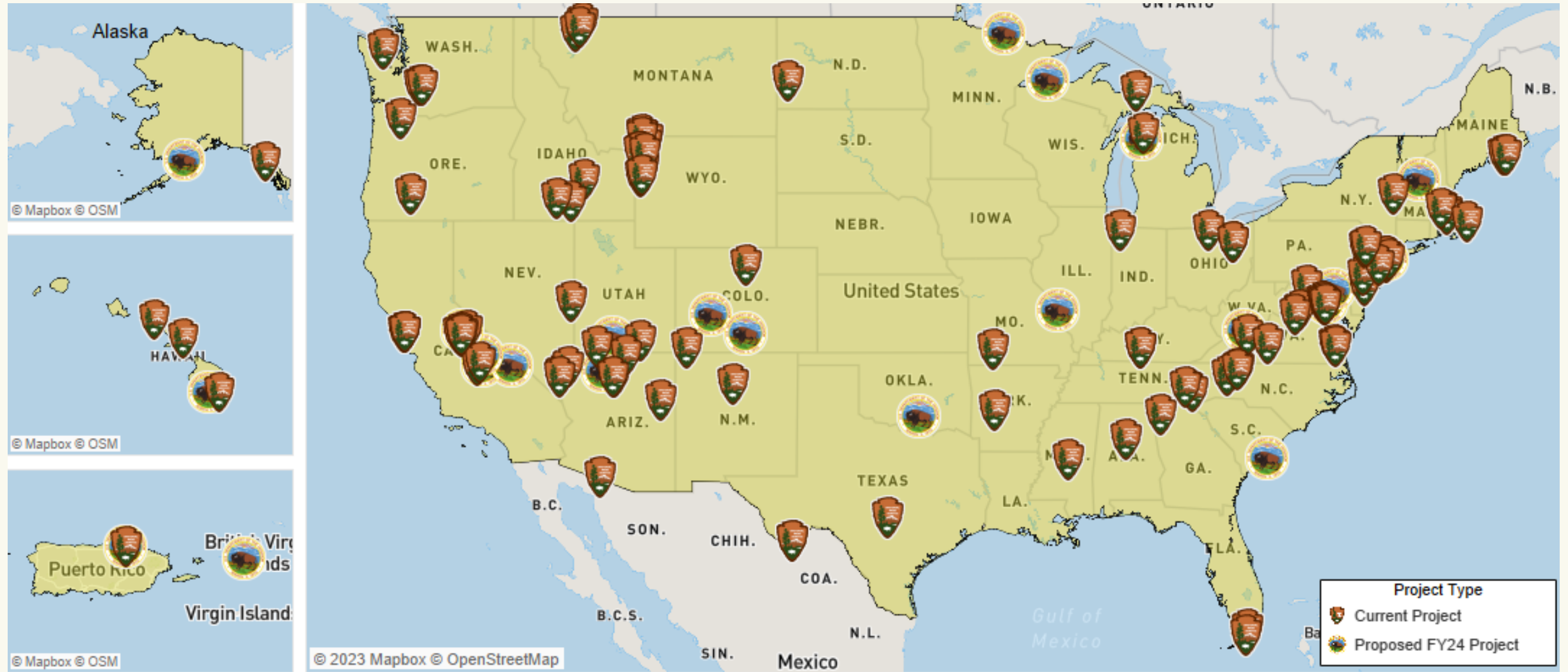
- Small Businesses (55%)

In 2021, the latest published scorecard, DOI received an A+ rating, achieving 133% of small business goals.
